

Miroslav Grohol, M.D. is a member of the Board of SPA SkMA

He is a newly-elected member of the Board, with a past experience as a member of the Supervisory board of the Slovak Psychiatric Association. Since completing studies of general medicine at the Medical Faculty of the Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice in 2001, he works at St. James's Hospital in Bardejov. In 2004 he passed the 1st Qualification Examination in Psychiatry, in 2008 the Specialty Exam in Psychiatry. During his career he has gained parallel experience at the bed unit of the department of psychiatry, (since 2016 in the position of the head of the department), at the daily hospital and the outpatient unit. He has received training in group psychoanalytic therapy, focus psychodynamic therapy, in the basics of hypnosis, psychotraumatology and EMDR, and arttherapy. He is also personally involved in the area of addiction medicine, since 2014 at the post of the chair of the Section of Drug Addictions of SPA, and is a member of the editorial board of two journals in the field: Alcoholism and Drug Addictions (Alkoholizmus a drogové závislosti) and Addictology in Prevention and Treatment Practice (Adiktologie v preventivní a léčebné praxi). He has published two monographs on alcoholism. He is active in organising conference meetings of professionals in addiction, and in the transformation of organization of psychiatric care.
