In 2006 he graduated from the Jessenius Medical Faculty of Comenius University in Martin. First he worked as a doctor in the Czech Republic, since 2008 he has been working at Psychiatric clinic of Slovak Medical University in Roosevelt Teaching Hospital in Banská Bystrica, where he has been the head since 2020. In 2013 he completed his specialisation studies in psychiatry, in 2017 he completed basic training in relaxation-symbolic psychotherapy and in 2020 he completed his PhD studies in psychiatry at the Faculty of Medicine of Comenius University in Bratislava. He is engaged in teaching activities at the Faculty of Health of the Slovak Medical University in Banská Bystrica, in addition to lecturing, publishing and outreach activities. In 2015-2022 he was the chairman of the Ethics Committee of the Slovak Psychiatric Association, since 2018 he has been the editor-in-chief of slovak journal Alcoholism and Drug Addictions, he was also a member of the editorial board of slovak journal Psychiatry-Psychotherapy-Psychosomatics. His main areas of expertise are psychopathology, problems of human sexuality, philosophical contexts and spiritual aspects of psychiatry.
